QUALIFICATIONS

The candidate must be:

A member of the **Society** for at least three years.

A member of the Pasadena Chapter who is active and involved in the chapter

A member who has never attended Harmony College and might not otherwise have the opportunity to do so.

A member who will personally benefit from attending Harmony College.

A member who will bring his new-found knowledge back and share it with his chapter.

A member with a strong desire to learn about and promote barbershop harmony.

Guidelines for submission

The scholarship will only cover Harmony College West tuition. All other expenses, including transportation, are the responsibility of the candidate.

The application must be received by the Pasadena Chapter Secretary by May 1, 2010. Harmony College West is scheduled for July 16-18, 2010.

The Pasadena Chapter Board of Directors will establish the total amount that is available for awards in first board meeting of May. Not all of the amount need be awarded. The screening committee can petition the board of Directors prior to May 15th for additional funds.

A screening board of four composed of two members of the Music Committee and two members of the Board of directors will determine the recipients of the scholarships and submit them to the Pasadena Chapter Board of Directors for acceptance and presentation.

After being notified, the recipient is responsible for making all arrangements to attend Harmony College West and submitting a request for reimbursement of the tuition to the chapter treasurer.
